This morning you have become a part of history, the history of Saint David Parish. This is our first Sunday together; this is our first bulletin. This afternoon, at the rectory, we will have the first baptisms.

A special "thank you" and "God bless you" to all those who helped get the rectory in order and who helped in setting up this, our temporary church. We are grateful to Franke's Motors for letting us use their building. This wonderful spirit of cooperation makes my work so much easier.

Now a word about myself. The late Cardinal Glennon ordained our class at Kenricks Seminary, June 2, 1945. My first appointment was to the Old Cathedral and Saint Raymond Maronite Church, where I remained until February 1946, at which time I was sent to Immaculate Conception Church in Jefferson City. In 1950, Archbishop Ritter transferred me to Holy Innocents Church in Saint Louis, I remained until 1957, when I was sent to the Church of the Resurrection, also in Saint Louis, then in May of this year, I received the thrilling news that I had been made Pastor; I had been given the honor of founding the new church of Saint David, in Arnold, Missouri..... and so here I am.

On next Sunday, August 18th., a second collection will be taken up for the Saint Louis Missions in La Paz and Viachia, Bolivia, where nine of our priests are caring for over 50,000 Catholics. Your Priests have given themselves; Please be generous.

School Registration. All children from Saint David's Parish who attended Immaculate Conception School last year, and first grade pupils will be kept in school. All will be required to register on Sunday August 18th. Any child who is not registered that date will be presumed to be attending a school other than Immaculate Conception. Readiness Tests for children attending grade one will be held on Tuesday August 20th. All first grade children must be present at 9:00..., at Immaculate Conception.

Tuition for our children attending Immaculate Conception School will be 5.00 per month, per child. Tuition and bus fare will be paid here at Saint David's. The Bus Association will be in the Cafeteria of the – School Building, at Immaculate Conception, next Sunday to take applications for the transporting of our children. Saint David's Parish will use the transportation next year, must register, so they can plan their routes etc.

Ziegler's Market has permitted us to use parking space, but request that we use the space on the east side of the store.

Thursday is a Holy Day of Obligation, the feast of Mary's Assumption into Heaven. At present we have no arrangements for Mass on Holy Days; you will have to attend Mass at Immaculate Conception. Arrangements will be made for Holy Days, in the future. Daily Mass will begin in the chapel at the rectory August 19th, at 7:00 AM. If this is inconvenient for most people who want to attend daily Mass, the time will be changed to suit their convenience.
